



Lindsey has over 20 years experience training animals, primarily dogs and horses. For the last thirteen years she has owned and run her own training company, Ricochet Pawsitive Training, aka Ricochet K9. She trains all breeds of dogs for a variety of purposes, all using gentle, humane methods that encourage the dog to think, like clicker training. She specializes in training service dogs for their disabled owners as well as using behavior modification to rehabilitate aggressive and/or fearful dogs. She has a passion for dog behavior and takes every opportunity to observe dogs interacting with each other. She believes that the time spent just watching dogs be dogs is invaluable for anyone with an interest in training because it truly helps us humans learn why dogs act the way that they do.

Lindsey has been involved in numerous areas of the dog world over the years. She bred and shown Jack Russell Terriers for several years, achieving countless top honors in several events at Jack Russell Terrier Club of America competitions all over the country. She also served as an obedience and agility judge at a number of competitions as well as the Obedience and Agility Chairman of the Southwest Jack Russell Terrier Network. During this time she was also very interested in genetics of the breed and did extensive research on Legg-Calve Perthes and hereditarily enlarged hearts. Lindsey was also interviewed and quoted for a training article in Dog Fancy's "Popular Dogs-Jack Russell Terriers" series, which wound up winning a Dog Writers' Association Maxwell Award. Lindsey began competing in dog agility with her homebred JRT, Lucky-Strike, in early 1999. In addition to her training business, Lindsey also owns and operates Star Dog Entertainment, a canine entertainment company that puts on Frisbee/trick dog shows for sporting events, parties, fairs, etc. The shows are a big hit with young and old alike. Star Dog works with the media as

well, providing dogs for commercials. Several of her dogs have been cast for commercials, both regional and national campaigns with companies such as Hasbro.

Other dog sports Lindsey is involved in include weight pull, scootering (aka dryland mushing), herding and Rally Obedience. The two sports you will find her most involved in however are Frisbee and dock diving. Her oldest Border Collie Cappuccino, is a natural at dock diving. They have spent many months doing dock diving at shows and exhibitions all across the country and in Mexico too for the Purina Incredible Dog Team. The entertainment show schedule doesn't leave much time for competing but when there is extra time they enjoy competing in dock diving and Frisbee events.
